This "whole house" approach can reduce utility costs by up to 50%. Another interesting program.

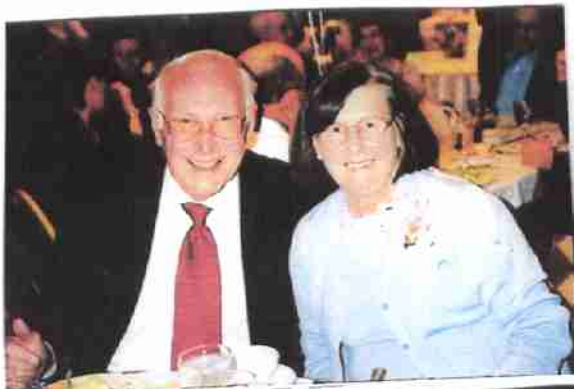

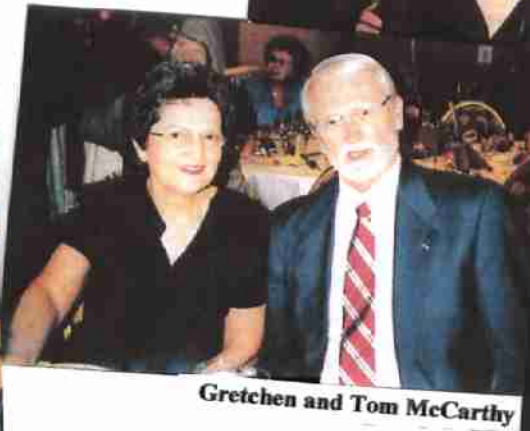

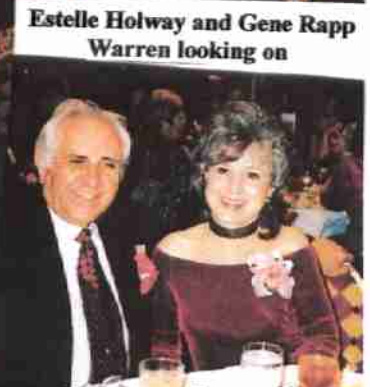
