The District's mission is to control mosquito and other vectors (ticks, yellow jackets, and any organism that will transmit a disease). Mosquitos were the focus of his power point presentation because they have been known to transmit diseases (in particular West Nile Virus) to humans and animals. Coincidentally, the district is spraying a fog mosquito killer this week in north Lincoln and side streets north of Sunset Blvd. West and in the area of Sun City Roseville. The application of Pyrocide 7396 is intended to kill adult mosquitos that are flying. Mosquitos need water to survive. It is important to eliminate standing water on your property. For ponds and swimming pools that are not in use, the District will provide fish to take care of the vectors at no charge. A fascinating program.
