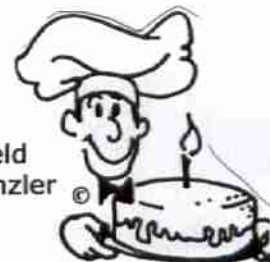
### A BLONDE IS BAAAACK

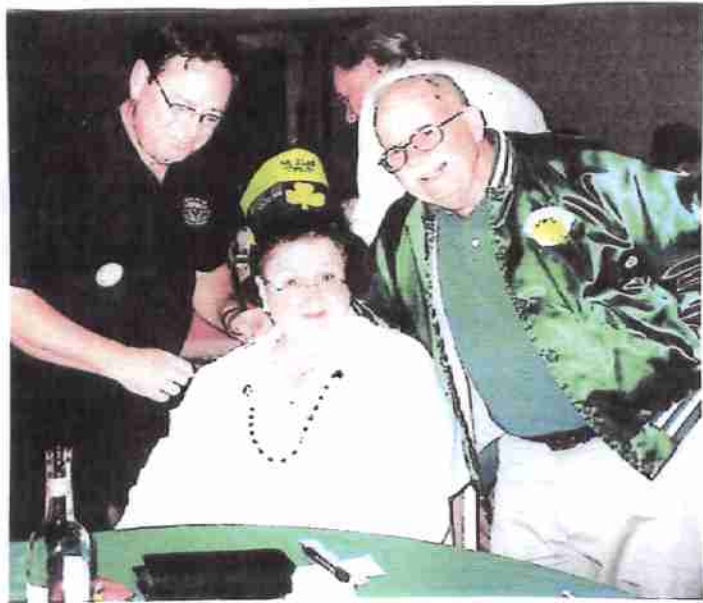
